



## OVERVIEW

---

The Florence Ballenger Scholarship provides financial support to students who have demonstrated academic excellence and commitment to civic services.

This scholarship is awarded to incoming, returning, and transfer students. Students who have completed a baccalaureate degree program are not eligible for this award.

Incoming and transfer students must satisfy all admissions requirements (submit an Admission Data Form, have official transcripts on file, take the placement test, if applicable) before the scholarship will be awarded.

**NOTE:** Financial Aid recipients should be aware that this scholarship may reduce the amount of government financial assistance. Applicants should contact a Financial Aid Advisor for additional information.

Faxed or email transmissions of the application will not be accepted.

The scholarship will be awarded once per semester (Fall and Spring only), and applied directly to your student account.

## ELIGIBILITY

---

- A cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above
- A completed financial aid file (FAFSA)
- Enrollment in six (6) or more credit hours
- Submission of a personal statement detailing your goals and interests.
